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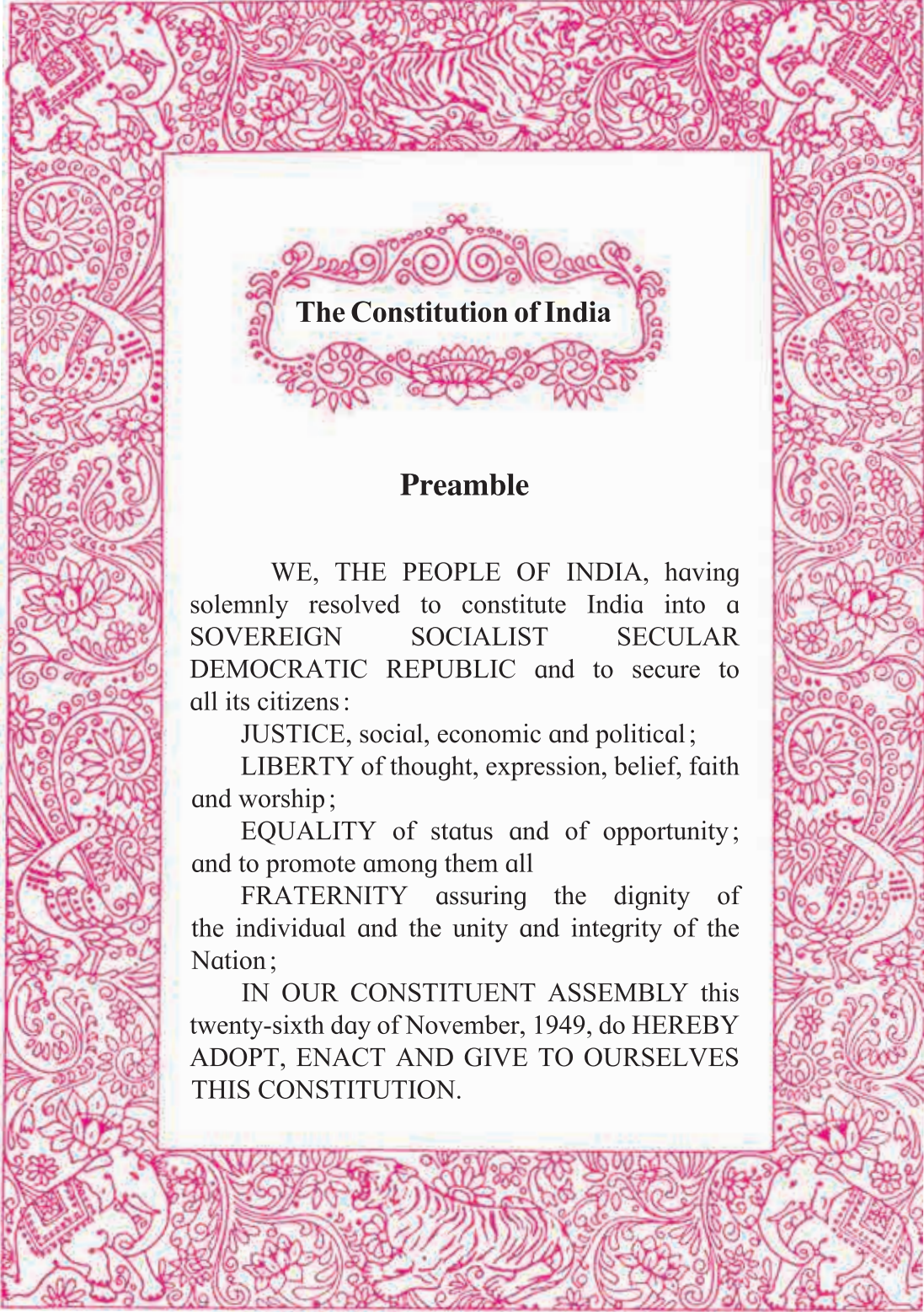
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The Constitution of India

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TEACHER'S PAGE

The book seeks to base itself on the communicative method of language learning, which prioritizes the act of communication above all else. In order to maximize the students' exposure to the language, this book uses a near-complete immersive method, meaning that the book is almost entirely written in Spanish. Concessions have been made to provide some grammar explanations in English in order to facilitate the clear understanding of these concepts. The structure of the book emphasizes the absorption and production in the language, rather than focusing on the memorization of vocabulary lists.

In order to meet the needs of the students, this book boasts of a variety of texts and dialogues in everyday, familiar situations. Grammar and vocabulary exercises have been provided to ensure that the students absorb and are able to produce language of a good quality. The chapters are thematically arranged, with the content in each chapter focussing on a central theme such as family, shopping, food, etc. Cultural briefs that are related to this topic are provided at the end of each chapter. To reinforce and fix the structures learnt in every chapter, there is a special section for *Más ejercicios* given at the end of the book, divided according to the content of each chapter. Every effort has been taken to ensure that the book is appealing not only in terms of content, but also in terms of aesthetics.
