

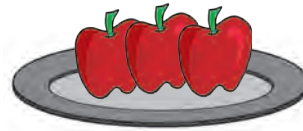
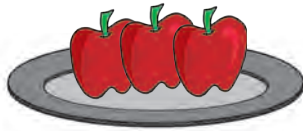


Addition and subtraction of Zero



Adding zero and subtracting zero.

Three apples in one dish. None in the other. Only three apples in all.



$$3 + 0 = 3$$

Rama has 2 apples. Her little sister loves apples. So, she kept both for her. She did not eat any.



$$2 - 0 = 2$$



If zero is added to any number, we get the same number again. We get the same result when we subtract zero.
