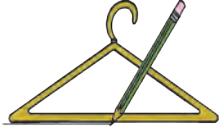
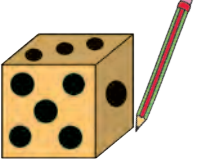
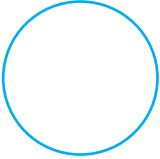
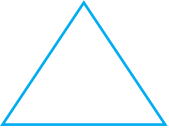


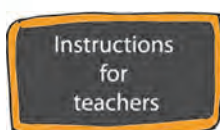
Let's identify geometrical shapes

* As shown in the picture, trace the edges of the objects with your pencil and draw the shape of the object. Observe the sides of the object.

			
			
This is a rectangle. A rectangle has 4 sides.	A circle has only one curved edge and no straight side.	This is a triangle. A triangle has 3 sides.	This is a square. A square has 4 sides.

Try the fun activities given below :

- * **Activity 1 :** Make a paper boat. Unfold it and count the numbers of triangles and four-sided figures; and colour any two triangles and four-sided two figures.
- * **Activity 2 :** Make triangles and four-sided figures using match sticks or small wooden strips.
- * **Activity 3 :** Find out the tools of games in which you see triangles, four-sided figures and circles.
- * **Activity 4 :** Make a picture using the shapes Δ , $\square$, $\bigcirc$ etc.



Give children practice in drawing various shapes using articles of daily use. Also give them practice in drawing these shapes free-hand.
