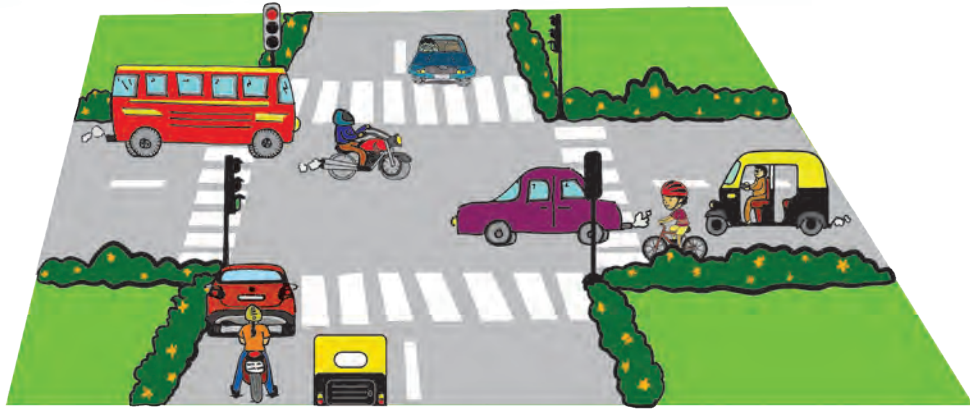

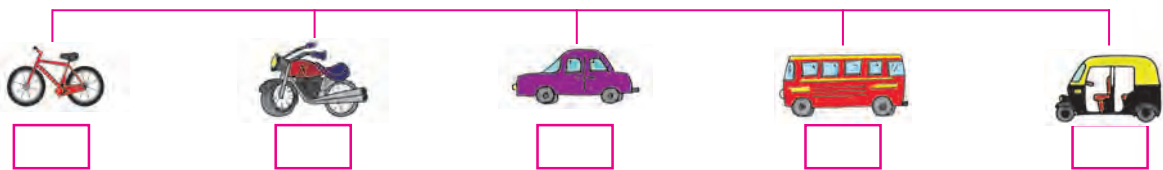
Observe the picture of the weekly market above and fill in the empty boxes.
