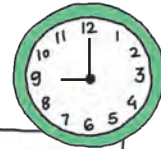


Morning

Hurry up, or you'll be late !



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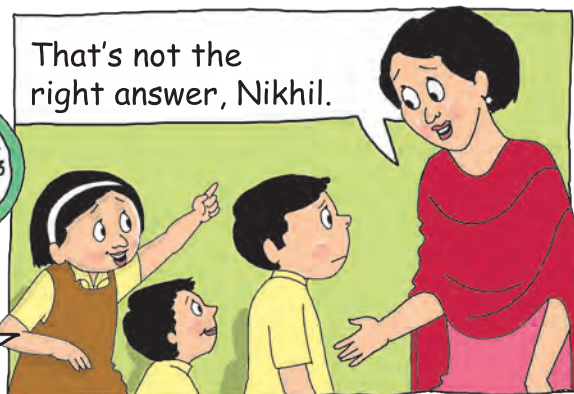
I think you should tell the teacher about it.



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That's not the right answer, Nikhil.



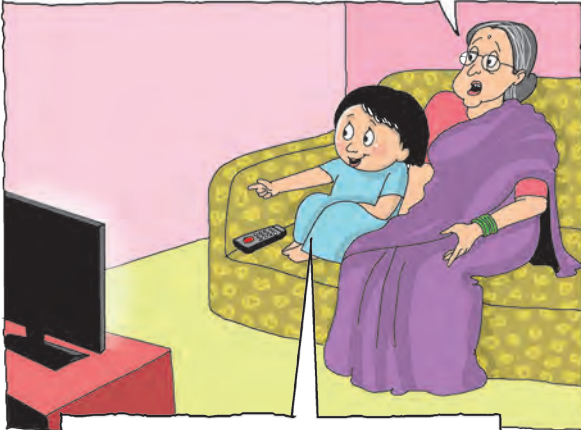
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For the Teacher : Let the children use their own imagination and experience for this activity. Encourage different or original ideas.

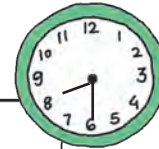
Evening



Why do you like the programme so much ?



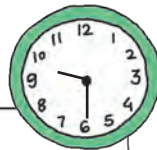
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You must eat everything that's on your plate.
